Old, old prophecies of Indigenous visionaries of Indigenous Nations on Turtle Island warned of Earth changes hundreds of thousands of years ago. Those warnings have not been heeded and lead us to the precipice today.

The issue of relational dynamics in natural law is ignored to human peril. Today wars are fought throughout the world, in numbers greater than any other time in the history of humanity, and the fundamental issues are water and food, not democracy.

Humanity’s relationship to Sentient beings in the natural world of the plant families, the animal families, and all life beings is now the foundational question that will determine our survival. The interlocking web of life is under peril of being demolished by the childish behaviour of greed that is defining the governments and corporations of the day. Modern civilizations are creating conditions that are causing economic terrorism and environmental genocide.

The challenge for humanity is to incorporate cultural ways of knowing these relational dynamics, having a profound respect for the natural world, into everyday thought and practice.

We must all learn about cultures throughout the world that locate the sacred in nature and have developed traditions of celebrating the sacred in their worldviews. There is much to learn from Indigenous Nations.
